Dear Parent/Guardian of EA Student,

As a result of the federal “No Child Left Behind Act”, your child can receive extra help in the areas of math, reading and language arts. You can receive this tutoring because Esperanza Academy is in its third year of School Improvement, and your family meets the income limits under the law.

EA did meet 12 required benchmarks in 15 categories measured by the No Child Left Behind Legislation. Attached is our school academic achievement report showing how we met these benchmarks and what benchmark we did not meet. - Can the tutor help if your child has disabilities or has limited use of the English language?
- Is transportation available to and from where the tutoring will take place?
